<b>TYPES OF CANNIBALISM</b>	<b>DEFINITION</b>
Exocannibalism	Eating non-group members
Endocannibalism	Eating group members
Ritual cannibalism	Eating people, usually in very small or symbolic portions, as part of a ritual
Vengeance cannibalism	Eating enemies
Aberrant behavior	Deranged individuals eating people
<b>ARCHAEOLOGICAL INDICATORS OF CANNIBALISM</b>	<b>EXAMPLES</b>
Modification to human bone	Butchery marks on human bone
	Artificially enlarged foramen magnum
	Charring or burning of human bone
Coprolites	Human coprolites containing human remains
Context	Human bone found mixed with food refuse
